

Zimbabwe National Water Authority RENEWAL OF BULK WATER DEALERS' LICENCES

The Zimbabwe National Water Authority (ZINWA) would like to advise all bulk water companies that in terms of statutory Instrument 90 of 2013, Water (Permits) (Amendment) Regulations, all bulk water licences and certificates expire on December 31 2022 and should be renewed on or before the date.

All those companies and dealers wishing to continue with the business after the date are therefore advised to renew their licences and avoid the inconveniences associated with late registration. Failure to renew licences will result in the bulk water dealers concerned being charged penalties as prescribed by the law. New players wishing to enter to bulk water business should also apply for the relevant certificates and licences.

Bulk water dealers intending to surrender their licences are also advised that in terms of the same law, they are required to notify ZINWA in writing at least 30 days before the stoppage of their business. ZINWA would like to reiterate that any acts of non-compliance after the December 31, deadline will not be tolerated.

All bulk water companies intending to renew, surrender or get new licences are therefore advised to visit ZINWA Groundwater Offices at the ZINWA Engineering Services Department Offices situated at 6 Pauling Drive, opposite the Josiah Magama Tongogara Barracks in Harare.
